BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 42F-103, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- 3 "(a) Grants shall be awarded only to individuals who, and
- 4 organizations that:
- 5 (1) Are licensed or accredited, in accordance with
- 6 federal, state, or county statutes, rules, or
- 7 ordinances, to conduct the activities or provide the
- 8 services for which a grant is awarded;
- 9 (2) Comply with all applicable federal and state laws
- 10 prohibiting discrimination against any person on the
- 11 basis of race, color, national origin, religion,
- creed, sex, age, sexual orientation, or disability;
- 13 (3) Agree not to use state funds for entertainment or
- 14 lobbying activities; [and]
- (4) Allow the state agency to which funds for the grant
- 16 were appropriated for expenditure, legislative
- 17 committees and their staff, and the auditor full

1		access to their records, reports, files, and other
2		related documents and information for purposes of
3		monitoring, measuring the effectiveness, and ensuring
4		the proper expenditure of the grant [-]; and
5	(5)	Are not current members of the legislature in the case
6		of individuals; or have governing boards in which no
7		member is a current member of the legislature in the
8		case of organizations."
