A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DECEPTIVE TRADE PRACTICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Hawaii residents are 2 often barred from claiming offers for free or reduced rate 3 shipping, which are more commonly available to purchasers in 4 other states. Many retailers also apply an arbitrary shipping 5 cost to Hawaii residents, which does not correlate with the actual cost of shipping. The purpose of this Act is to 6 7 establish that charging shipping and delivery charges that 8 exceed the actual cost to ship or deliver a commodity to a 9 consumer in Hawaii shall constitute an unfair and deceptive 10 practice.

SECTION 2. Chapter 481B, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to read as follows:
