A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ALCOHOL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 244D-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending the definition of "beer" to read as follows:
3	""Beer" means any alcoholic beverage containing no less
4	than 0.5 per cent alcohol by volume obtained by the fermentation
5	or any infusion or decoction of [barley,] malt, [hops, or any
6	other similar product, or any combination thereof in water, and]
7	wholly or in part, or any substitute therefor, including grain
8	of any kind, bran, glucose, sugar, or molasses. "Beer" includes
9	ale, porter, brown, stout, lager beer, small beer, [and] strong
10	beer, and alcoholic seltzer beverages, but does not include
11	sake, known as Japanese rice wine, or cooler beverage."
12	SECTION 2. Section 281-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
13	amended by amending the definition of "beer" to read as follows:
14	""Beer" means any <u>alcoholic</u> beverage <u>containing no less</u>
15	than 0.5 per cent alcohol by volume obtained by the alcoholic
16	fermentation of any infusion or decoction of [barley or other
17	grain, malt, [and hops in water.] wholly or in part, or any

- 1 substitute therefor, including grain of any kind, bran, glucose,
- 2 sugar, or molasses."
- 3 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 4 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 5 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2022.
