A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
SEVENTEENTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
general obligation bonds in the sum of \$54,950,000 or so much
thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum or so much thereof
as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2021-2022
for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the
seventeenth senatorial district, as follows:

1. August Ahrens Elementary School

A. Design and construction of a new
classroom building, ground and
site improvements, equipment, and
appurtenances.

5 SECTION 2. The appropriations made for the capital
6 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
7 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriations are
8 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriations that are
9 unencumbered as of June 30, 2024, shall lapse as of that date.

10 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
11 capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be
12 expended by the department of education for the purposes of this
13 Act.

14 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2021.
