A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that public members of 2 boards and commissions more adequately represent the public 3 interest when those members have no association with the profession or any relationship with a member of the profession 4 that the board or commission regulates. Public members are not 5 6 expected or required to be experienced or an expert in the regulated profession. This unique and important role of the 7 8 public member mitigates the anticompetitive effects of a board 9 or commission's actions, which may occur when the board or 10 commission is dominated by active market participants. 11 The legislature further finds that well-informed and

11 The legislature further finds that well-informed and 12 engaged public members bring several advantages to regulation 13 including:

(1) Reducing the potential for board decisions which favor

10	the composition of each board and commission shall be as	
11	provided by law. A public member of any board or commission	
12	listed in subsection (c) shall not:

14	(2) Be associated with a member of the occupation that the	
15	board or commission regulates that results in a	
16	material conflict of interest, an appearance of	
17	impropriety, or a reasonable suspicion that the public

Prohibits a public member of any board or commission under DCCA's purview from being engaged in the occupation that the board or commission regulates; being associated with a member of the occupation that the board or commission regulates that results in a material conflict of interest, an appearance of impropriety, or a reasonable suspicion that the public member does not represent the public interest; or having a financial interest in the regulated occupation.
