### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE MINIMUM WAGE.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 387-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 3 Except as provided in section 387-9 and this section, "(a) 4 every employer shall pay to each employee employed by the 5 employer, wages at the rate of not less than: 6 (1)\$6.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2003; (2) \$6.75 per hour beginning January 1, 2006; 8 (3) \$7.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2007; \$7.75 per hour beginning January 1, 2015; 9 (4)10 \$8.50 per hour beginning January 1, 2016; (5) 11 \$9.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2017; [and] (6) 12 \$10.10 per hour beginning January 1, 2018[-]; and (7) 13 \$15.00 per hour beginning June 1, 2023." 14 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 15 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
