### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION	1.	Chapter	431,	Hawaii	Revised	Statutes,	is
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2 amended as follows:

3 1. By adding a new section to article 10A, part I, to be4 appropriately designated and to read:

5 "<u>\$431:10A-A</u> Annual mental health screening coverage. (a)

6 Each individual policy of accident and health or sickness

7 insurance issued or renewed in this State after December 31,

8 2021, except for policies that only provide coverage for a

9 specified disease or other limited benefit coverage as described

10 in section 431:10A-607, shall provide coverage for annual mental

- 11 <u>health screenings.</u>
- 12 (b) Each accident and health or sickness insurer shall

13 reimburse all costs associated with the coverage under

14 subsection (a) to any physician or health care provider

15 complying with this section."

4	SECTION 3. Section 432D-23, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
5	amended to read as follows:
6	"§432D-23 Required provisions and benefits.
7	Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, each
8	policy, contract, plan, or agreement issued in the State after
9	January 1, 1995, by health maintenance organizations pursuant to
10	this chapter, shall include benefits provided in sections
11	431:10-212, 431:10A-115, 431:10A-115.5, 431:10A-116, 431:10A-
12	116.2, 431:10A-116.5, 431:10A-116.6, 431:10A-119, 431:10A-120,
13	431:10A-121, 431:10A-122, 431:10A-125, 431:10A-126, 431:10A-132,
14	431:10A-133, <u>431:10A-134,</u> 431:10A-140, [ <del>and 431:10A-134,</del> ]
15	431:10A-A, and 431:10A-B, and chapter 431M."
16	SECTION 4. The benefit to be provided by health
17	maintenance organizations corresponding to the benefit provided
18	under sections 431:10A-A and 431:10A-B, Hawaii Revised Statutes,
19	as contained in the amendment to section 432D-23, Hawaii Revised
20	Statutes, in section 3 of this Act, shall take effect for all

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policies, contracts, plans, or agreements issued in the State
 after December 31, 2021.

3 SECTION 5. (a) The auditor shall conduct an impact
4 assessment report pursuant to sections 23-51 and 23-52, Hawaii
5 Revised Statutes, to assess the social and financial impacts of
6 the mandate specified in sections 1, 2, 3, and 4 of this Act.

7 (b) The auditor shall submit a report of its findings and 8 recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the 9 legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of 10 the regular session of 2022.

SECTION 6. In codifying the new sections added by section 12 1 of this Act, the revisor of statutes shall substitute 13 appropriate section numbers for the letters used in designating 14 the new sections in this Act.

15 SECTION 7. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed16 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

17 SECTION 8. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2021.
