## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE PUBLIC HOUSING AUTHORITY.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 356D-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended as follows:
- 3 1. By amending subsection (a) to read:
- 4 "(a) The authority, in its own behalf or on behalf of any
- 5 government, may:
- 6 (1) Clear, improve, and rehabilitate property; and
- 7 (2) Plan, develop, construct, and finance [public] housing
- 8 projects."
- 9 2. By amending subsection (e) to read:
- 10 "(e) The authority may contract or sponsor with any
- 11 county, housing authority, or person, subject to the
- 12 availability of funds, [an experimental or demonstration] a
- 13 housing project designed to meet the needs of elders, disabled,
- 14 displaced or homeless persons, low- and moderate-income persons,
- 15 government employees, teachers, or university and college
- 16 students and faculty."
- 3. By amending subsection (f) to read:

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- 1 "(f) The authority may enter into contracts with eligible
- 2 developers to develop [public] housing projects in exchange for
- 3 mixed use development rights. Eligibility of a developer for an
- 4 exchange pursuant to this subsection shall be determined
- 5 pursuant to rules adopted by the authority in accordance with
- 6 chapter 91.
- 7 As used in this subsection, "mixed use development rights"
- 8 means the right to develop a portion of a public housing project
- 9 for commercial use."
- 10 4. By amending subsection (h) to read:
- "(h) In connection with the development of any public
- 12 housing dwelling units under this chapter, the authority may
- 13 also develop non-subsidized housing, commercial properties, and
- 14 industrial properties and sell or lease other properties if it
- 15 determines that the uses will be an integral part of the public
- 16 housing development or a benefit to the community in which the
- 17 properties are situated. The authority may designate any
- 18 portions of the public housing development for non-subsidized
- 19 housing, commercial, industrial, or other use and shall have all
- 20 the powers granted under this chapter with respect thereto. The

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- authority may use any funding authorized under this chapter to 1
- implement this subsection. 2
- The net proceeds of all sales or leases, less costs to the 3
- authority, shall be deposited in the public housing revolving 4
- fund established by section 356D-28." 5
- SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 6
- and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 7
- SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval. 8
