
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TAX CREDITS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 201, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	"§201- Specific economic activity tax credits; public
5	disclosure. Upon certification by the department that a
6	taxpayer has received any tax credit under sections 235-17 and
7	235-110.91, or chapter 209E, the department shall file a public
8	disclosure identifying the name of the taxpayer who received the
9	tax credit and the total amount of tax credit received."
10	SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
11	SECTION 3. This Act, upon its approval, shall apply to
12	taxable years beginning after December 31, 2021.
