BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 201B-10, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
- 3 "(b) Moneys in the special fund shall be used exclusively
- 4 to provide for the development and implementation of emergency
- 5 measures that directly relate to safety and security initiatives
- 6 necessary to respond to any tourism emergency pursuant to
- 7 section 201B-9, including providing emergency assistance to
- 8 tourists during the tourism emergency."
- 9 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
