BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

3	"State agency" means any department, commission, council,		
4	board, bureau, authority, institution, legislative body, agency,		
5	committee, government corporation, or other establishment or		
6	office of the executive, legislative, or judicial branch of the		
7	State, including the office of Hawaiian affairs.		
8	"State funds" means any moneys appropriated to or		
9	authorized to be expended by a state agency. "State funds"		
10	shall be construed broadly to include any moneys from any fund		
11	from which a state agency may make expenditure, whether the fund		
12	is within or outside of the state treasury."		
13	SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that		
14	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were		
15	begun before its effective date.		
16	SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.		
17	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2021.
