SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

ENCOURAGING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, COMPLEX AREAS, AND CHARTER SCHOOLS TO IMPLEMENT SCHOOL-WIDE RESTORATIVE PRACTICES IN THE STATE'S PUBLIC AND CHARTER SCHOOLS.

WHEREAS, studies show that suspension and expulsion, which 1 are traditional methods of addressing disciplinary issues in 2 3 schools, do not make schools safer and result in lower graduation rates and increased rates of involvement in the 4 juvenile justice system, thus expanding the school to prison 5 6 pipeline; and 7 WHEREAS, restorative practices are a values-based approach 8 to community building, problem solving, and conflict resolution 9 that builds and restores relationships, creates opportunities 10 for dialogue, repairs harm, transforms conflict, and creates 11 equitable learning environments in schools; and 12 13 WHEREAS, restorative practices encourage students to engage 14 in collaborative problem solving, which empowers students and 15 gives them tools to effectively communicate beyond the school 16 17 setting; and 18 WHEREAS, restorative practices, in a school setting, shift 19 20 the emphasis from managing behavior to focusing on building, nurturing, and repairing relationships, while retaining the 21 ability to hold students accountable; and 22 23 WHEREAS, restorative practices focus on the impact of 24 students' behavior on other members of the school community, 25 rather than only on rule-breaking, and allows those impacted to 26 find ways to repair the harm and restore damaged relationships, 27 rather than imposing punishment; and 28 29 WHEREAS, studies have shown that restorative practices can 30 31 lead to reductions in problem behavior; improvements in school

climate; and increases in student achievement, attendance, and 1 graduation rates; and 2 3 4 WHEREAS, there is a continuum of proactive to responsive restorative practices, ranging from community-building circles 5 6 to restorative conferencing, which are accessible to educators who can then use those funds to successfully implement school-7 8 wide restorative practices; now, therefore, 9 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-first 10 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2021, the 11 House of Representatives concurring, that the Department of 12 Education, complex areas, and charter schools are encouraged to 13 14 implement school-wide restorative practices in Hawaii's public and charter schools; and 15 16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 17 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the 18 Board of Education, Superintendent of Education, Chairperson of 19 the Hawaii State Charter School Commission, and Executive 20 Director of the Hawaii State Charter School Commission. 21
