## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND KAUAI DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO CONDUCT A STUDY TO IDENTIFY AND RECOMMEND METHODS TO ALLEVIATE TRAFFIC CONGESTION AT CERTAIN INTERSECTIONS ALONG THE KAUMUALII HIGHWAY.

WHEREAS, the Kaumualii Highway is a thirty-three-mile 1 2 roadway in the County of Kauai that stretches from the intersection of Kuhio Highway and Rice Street to Lio Road, 3 passing through the communities of Lihue, Omao, Koloa, Kalaheo, 4 5 and Waimea, among others; and 6 7 WHEREAS, Kauai's economy is a combination of agriculture, 8 business, construction, education, state and local government, technology and defense, and tourism; and 9 10 11 WHEREAS, according to a list provided by InfoGroup of the largest employers in the County of Kauai, seventeen of the 12 13 county's fifty-two largest employers are located in communities near the Kaumualii Highway, including Koloa, Poipu, and Waimea; 14 15 and 16 WHEREAS, although not included in InfoGroup's list, the 17 Pacific Missile Range Facility Barking Sands is one of Kauai's 18 19 largest employers, with nearly one thousand active duty Navy and government personnel, civil service and contract civilians, and 20 Hawaii Air National Guard members employed by the facility, and 21 is located approximately one-fifth of a mile south of the 22 Kaumualii Highway on the western shore of Kauai; and 23 24 25 WHEREAS, according to data provided by Statistical Atlas, Kalaheo has the fourth largest population in Kauai County; and 26

WHEREAS, according to the United States Census Bureau, the 1 population in Kauai County increased by 7.7 percent between 2 3 April 1, 2010, and July 1, 2019; and 4 5 WHEREAS, according to the 2018 State of Hawaii Data Book, 6 the number of vehicle registrations in the County of Kauai 7 increased by fifteen percent between 2010 and 2018, and the 8 twenty-four-hour traffic volume in certain survey sites in the 9 county increased between 2012 and 2018 by approximately ten percent in Waimea and thirteen percent in Omao; and 10 11 WHEREAS, the County of Kauai's growing population and the 12 presence of numerous large employers near the Kaumualii Highway 13 necessitate a collaborative effort by the State and county to 14 develop methods to alleviate traffic congestion along and 15 enhance the reliability of the Kaumualii Highway; now, 16 17 therefore. 18 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-first 19 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2021, the 20 House of Representatives concurring, that the Department of 21 Transportation and Kauai Department of Public Works are 22 requested to conduct a joint study to identify and recommend 23 methods to alleviate traffic congestion at the following 24 intersections located in the County of Kauai: 25 26 27 (1)Kaumualii Highway and Opu Road; and 28 Kaumualii Highway and Maluhia Road; and 29 (2) 30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the study is requested to 31 32 include a timeline and estimated costs to implement the Department of Transportation and Kauai Department of Public 33 34 Works' recommendations; and 35 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of 36 37 Transportation and Kauai Department of Public Works are also requested to submit a joint report of their findings and 38 recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the 39 40 Legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2022; and 41
