SENATE RESOLUTION

URGING THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO INSTALL A ROOF
COVERING THE RESTROOM FACILITIES AT PUULOA BEACH PARK.

1 WHEREAS, Puuloa Beach Park, formerly known as Ewa Beach
2 Park, is a popular five-acre park on Oahu's southwest shoreline;
3 and

5 WHEREAS, Puuloa Beach Park includes open-air, unroofed
6 restroom facilities; and
7

8 WHEREAS, due to the open-air nature of these restroom
9 facilities, individuals are able, and have been reported, to
10 scale the facilities' walls to peer inside the restrooms; and
11

12 WHEREAS, these restroom facilities are also prone to
13 flooding during periods of heavy rainfall, thereby damaging the
14 facilities and creating a potential hazard to park users; and

16 WHEREAS, installing a roof covering the restroom facilities
17 at Puuloa Beach Park would make the restroom facilities more
18 secure and improve the quality of life for residents of, and
19 visitors to, Ewa Beach and the City and County of Honolulu; now,
20 therefore,

22 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-first
23 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2021,
24 that the City and County of Honolulu is urged to install a roof
25 covering the restroom facilities at Puuloa Beach Park; and

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
28 Resolution be transmitted to the Mayor of the City and County of
29 Honolulu, Chair of the Honolulu City Council, Director of Parks
30 and Recreation of the City and County of Honolulu, Director of
