WHEREAS, the Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation (APEC) is a regional economic forum established in 1989, that aims to create greater prosperity for the people of the region by promoting balanced, inclusive, sustainable, innovative and secure growth and by accelerating regional economic integration; and

7 WHEREAS, APEC is the only international intergovernmental 8 grouping in the world committed to reducing barriers to trade 9 and investment without requiring its members to enter into 10 legally binding obligations, but endeavors to achieve its goals 11 by promoting dialogue and arriving at decisions on a consensus 12 basis, giving equal weight to the views of all members; and 13

WHEREAS, APEC's twenty-one member economies, comprised of 14 Australia; Brunei Darussalam; Canada; Chile; People's Republic 15 of China; Hong Kong, China; Indonesia; Japan; Republic of Korea; 16 Malaysia; Mexico; New Zealand; Papua New Guinea; Peru; The 17 Philippines; The Russian Federation; Singapore; Chinese Taipei; 18 19 Thailand; United States of America; and Viet Nam, represent over 20 forty percent of the world's population and over fifty percent 21 of the world's trade; and

WHEREAS, every year, one of the twenty-one APEC members
plays host to APEC meetings (Summit) and serves as the APEC
Chair; and
