## SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF HAWAIIAN HOME LANDS, IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE COUNTY OF HAWAII DEPARTMENT OF WATER SUPPLY, TO PROVIDE A PROGRESS REPORT REGARDING THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE KA'Ū WATER SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, Act 49, Session Laws of Hawaii 2017, allocated, 1 among other things, \$1,500,000 in general obligation bonds for 2 3 the plans, design, and construction for the development of the Ka'ū water system; and 4 5 6 WHEREAS, Phase 1 of the project includes the design and 7 construction of a one hundred-thousand-gallon water storage tank and appurtenances on Hawaiian home lands; and 8 9 10 WHEREAS, the Hawaiian Homes Commission approved \$500,000 in 11 trust funds for construction; and 12 13 WHEREAS, the estimated advertisement for bids was expected to occur in early 2020; and 14 15 16 WHEREAS, it is understood that the Department of Hawaiian Home Lands invited twenty-five pastoral lessees to discuss the 17 18 water needs for each lot and supplemental water availability; 19 and 20 WHEREAS, it is expected that Phase 2 of the project will 21 include repair and replacement of pressure reducing valve 22 stations; and 23 24 WHEREAS, it is further expected that Phase 3 of the project 25 will include the relocation of existing waterlines from within 26 leased lots to the South Point Road right-of-way, installation 27 of new water meters, fire protection, and the subdivision of 28 twenty-five pastoral lots; and 29 30 WHEREAS, because of the complexities and future costs of 31 the Ka'ū water system project, it would be prudent for the 32

Legislature to receive an update on the progress of the project; 1 2 now, therefore, 3 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-first 4 5 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2021, that the Department of Hawaiian Home Lands, in conjunction with 6 7 the County of Hawaii Department of Water Supply, is requested to 8 provide a progress report regarding the development of the Ka' $\hat{u}$ 9 water system; and 10 11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Hawaiian Home Lands is requested to submit the progress report to the 12 Legislature by June 30, 2021; and 13 14 15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Resolution be transmitted to the Governor, Chairperson of the 16 17 Hawaiian Homes Commission, and Manager of the County of Hawaii Department of Water Supply. 18
