SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE OFFICE OF PRIMARY CARE AND RURAL HEALTH TO FACILITATE DISCUSSIONS WITH KEY COMMUNITY HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICE ORGANIZATIONS WITHIN WEST HAWAII AND MAJOR HEALTHCARE STAKEHOLDERS IN SENATE DISTRICT 3 TO ADDRESS THE HEALTH AND WELLNESS NEEDS OF THE MOST VULNERABLE BY ALIGNING THE GOALS AND OBJECTIVES OF KEY ORGANIZATIONS INTO ONE SHARED 2030 HEALTH VISION PLAN.

1 WHEREAS, the purpose of "One Shared Vision" is to establish closer professional interactions, collaborations, and 2 3 educational opportunities across the various health, medical, specialty, social service, and environmental health professions 4 5 to simultaneously improve public health; and 6 7 WHEREAS, the coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) worldwide pandemic continues to burden the nation's health care systems; 8 and 9 10 11 WHEREAS, as of January 6, 2021, the State Department of Health reported 25,470 cases of COVID-19 and 299 deaths from 12 13 COVID-19 statewide with 2,526 cases of COVID-19 being reported for the County of Hawaii; and 14 15 WHEREAS, health is an extremely important issue especially 16 as the SARS-CoV-2 virus continues to spread and possibly mutate; 17 and 18 19 WHEREAS, health issues require examination of the social 20 determinants that involve continuous availability of resources 21 and coordinated efforts at all levels; and 22 23 24 WHEREAS, the establishment of a strong health network based in west Hawai'i would allow west Hawai'i to serve as a model for 25 the rest of the State; and 26 27 WHEREAS, this model will result in a west Hawai'i plan 28 looking nine years ahead by aligning the multiple agencies that 29 30 influence health care, including preventative and primary health

care, specialty care, and urgent and emergency care in west 1 Hawai'i; now, therefore, 2 3 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-first 4 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2021, 5 that the Office of Primary Care and Rural Health is requested to 6 facilitate discussions with key community health and social 7 service organizations within west Hawai'i and major healthcare 8 9 stakeholders in Senate district 3 to address the health and wellness needs of the most vulnerable by aligning the goals and 10 11 objectives of key organizations into a 2030 One Shared Health 12 Vision Plan; and 13 14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Office of Primary Care and Rural Health is requested to submit the 2030 One Shared Health 15 Vision Plan for west Hawai'i to the Legislature no later than 16 twenty days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 17 2022; and 18 19 20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Resolution be transmitted to the Director of Health and Mayor of 21 the County of Hawaii. 22 23 24 OFFERED BY: 25
