SENATE RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO ASSIGN STUDENTS RESIDING IN HONOKAI HALE AND KO OLINA TO ATTEND THE PUBLIC SCHOOL COMPLEX WITHIN THE STUDENTS' GEOGRAPHIC AREA, THE NANAKULI COMPLEX.

WHEREAS, research demonstrates that overcrowding in schools 1 negatively affects student achievement levels, stress levels, 2 attendance, and concentration; and 3 4 WHEREAS, overcrowding also has a detrimental effect on 5 teacher morale and limits the time available for teachers to 6 adequately plan and deliver lectures; and 7 8 9 WHEREAS, multi-tracking is an approach used to address school overcrowding by dividing students and faculty into 10 multiple groups who attend school year-round on alternating 11 12 schedules; and 13 WHEREAS, students in multi-tracked schools have tested an 14 average of two percent lower than students in traditional 15 schools on national reading, math, and language assessments; and 16 17 WHEREAS, studies have shown that multi-tracking is more 18 expensive over the long term and can harm community and family 19 cohesion and lead to increased stress and burnout for students, 20 teachers, and parents; and 21 22 23 WHEREAS, multi-tracking is currently used in the Kapolei Complex, where overcrowding is a longstanding problem; and 24 25 WHEREAS, overcrowding in Kapolei Complex schools is at 26 least partially attributable to the Department of Education's 27 assignment of students to the Kapolei Complex from Honokai Hale 28 29 and Ko Olina; and 30 WHEREAS, reassigning these students to the Nanakuli Complex 31 would help balance the distribution of students among the 32 33 complex areas within the Leeward District and ease overcrowding

1 in the Kapolei Complex without the need to multi-track; now, 2 therefore, 3 4 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-first 5 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2021, the House of Representatives concurring, that, starting with the 6 7 2021-2022 academic year, the Department of Education is strongly urged to assign students residing in Honokai Hale and Ko Olina 8 to attend the public school complex within the students' 9 10 geographic area, the Nanakuli Complex; and 11 12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the Board of 13 Education, Superintendent of Education, and principals of all 14 15 schools in the Kapolei Complex and Nanakuli Complex. 16 17 OFFERED BY: Kurt Ferlle 18
