SENATE RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO INSTALL A RAISED CROSSWALK AT THE INTERSECTION OF KEONEULA BOULEVARD AND KAMAKANA STREET.

WHEREAS, according to the National Highway Traffic Safety 1 Administration, speeding is a contributing factor in nearly one-2 third of all motor vehicle fatalities in the United States; and 3 4 WHEREAS, in Hawaii, speeding is a contributing factor in 5 nearly fifty percent of all traffic fatalities; and 6 7 WHEREAS, the frequency of speeding vehicles at the 8 intersection of Keoneula Boulevard and Kamakana Street endangers 9 the residents of Ewa Beach: and 10 11 WHEREAS, installation of raised crosswalks is an effective 12 method of slowing traffic; and 13 14 WHEREAS, installing a raised crosswalk at the intersection 15 of Keoneula Boulevard and Kamakana Street would help to reduce 16 the number of speeding vehicles on the roadway and protect the 17 residents of Ewa Beach; now, therefore, 18 19 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-first 20 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2021, 21 that the Department of Transportation and City and County of 22 Honolulu are urged to replace with a raised crosswalk the 23 existing crosswalk located at the intersection of Keoneula 24 Boulevard and Kamakana Street; and 25 26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 27 Resolution be transmitted to the Director of Transportation, 28 Mayor of the City and County of Honolulu, Chair of the Honolulu 29 City Council, Director of the Honolulu Department of 30



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Transportation Services, Director of the Honolulu Department of 1 Design and Construction, and Chair of the Ewa Neighborhood 2 Board. 3
