Your Committee on Judiciary & Hawaiian Affairs, to which was referred H.B. No. 1023, H.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO A NONRESIDENT RECREATIONAL MARINE FISHING LICENSE,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to help the State identify and develop sustainable sources of funding to effectively manage its fisheries by establishing a nonresident recreational marine fishing license and associated fees.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure from the Department of Land and Natural Resources, Coral Fish Hawaii/Hawaii Sustainable Reef Fisheries, and one individual. Your Committee received testimony in opposition to this measure from two individuals. Your Committee received comments on this measure from Pono Advocacy and For the Fishes.

Your Committee finds that although Hawaii's marine fisheries attract thousands of nonresident visitors each year, Hawaii residents are solely responsible for paying the taxes that support the state fisheries management programs. As a result, nonresidents recreational fishers directly benefit from enjoyment of the State's marine fishery resources without directly contributing to the management of these valuable resources. This

measure will provide an additional source of funding to protect these resources.
