Your Committee on Government Reform, to which was referred
H.B. No. 22 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATED TO CAMPAIGN FINANCE,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to increase the amount of
fines that may be assessed:

- (1) Against a noncandidate committee for violations of
organizational report requirements; and
- (2) For violations of advertisement disclaimer requirements.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure
from the League of Women Voters of Hawaii. Your Committee
received testimony in opposition to this measure from one
individual. Your Committee received comments on this measure from
the Campaign Spending Commission and Common Cause Hawaii.

Your Committee finds that this measure supports transparency
around political elections and will improve accountability in the
conduct of noncandidate committees during election campaigns.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:

- (1) Changing its effective date to July 1, 2112, to encourage further discussion; and
- (2) Making a technical, nonsubstantive amendment for the purposes of clarity, consistency, and style.

No. 22, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Second Reading in the form attached hereto as H.B. No. 22, H.D. 1, and be referred to your Committee on Judiciary & Hawaiian Affairs.
