Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred H.B.  
No. 670, H.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT  
SYSTEM,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to authorize the forfeiture of  
certain Employees' Retirement System benefits, pursuant to court  
order, for state or county employees and designated beneficiaries  
who are convicted of an employment-related felony.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure  
from the Hawai'i State Ethics Commission, Common Cause Hawaii, and  
nine individuals. Your Committee received comments on this  
measure from the Board of Trustees of the Employees' Retirement  
System.

Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of H.B.  
No. 670, H.D. 1, and recommends that it pass Third Reading.
