Your Committee on Transportation, to which was referred  
H.C.R. No. 90 entitled:

"HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF  
TRANSPORTATION TO ESTABLISH A TASK FORCE TO MAKE  
RECOMMENDATIONS ON THE PROPER IDENTIFICATION AND DISPOSAL OF  
ABANDONED AND DERELICT VEHICLES LEFT ON THE STATE'S HIGHWAYS  
AND CITY AND COUNTY ROADWAYS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to request the Department of  
Transportation to establish a task force to make recommendations  
on the proper identification and disposal of abandoned and  
derelict vehicles in the State.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure  
from the Department of Transportation.

Your Committee finds that in 2018, more than 3,000 abandoned  
and derelict vehicles were removed from the streets in the City  
and County of Honolulu, an increase of over fifty percent from  
2017. Your Committee believes that the increase in abandoned and  
derelict vehicles in the State necessitates the creation of a task  
force to look at existing laws regarding abandoned and derelict  
vehicles to assist in finding more efficient methods of disposal,  
thereby improving the quality of life for residents and visitors  
of the State.
