Sirs:

Your Committee on Conference on the disagreeing vote of the Senate to the amendments proposed by the House of Representatives in S.B. No. 806, H.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO PUBLIC SCHOOL LANDS,"

having met, and after full and free discussion, has agreed to recommend and does recommend to the respective Houses the final passage of this bill in an amended form.

The purpose of this measure is to require the Attorney General, on behalf of the Department of Education, to institute proceedings to acquire certain land owned by the Mililani Town Association by voluntary action or condemnation.

Your Committee on Conference finds that the Mililani Town Association owns a parcel of land that fronts Mililani High School. Mililani High School desires to build an access ramp on this parcel that is compliant with the Americans for Disabilities Act to allow students, staff, family members, and the general public access to the school. Mililani Town Association is amenable to this construction and would like to avoid the potential for liability by transferring title to the parcel to the State. This measure

provides a legal process for the friendly condemnation of the parcel by the State in a manner agreeable to all parties.

Your Committee on Conference has amended this measure by changing the effective date to upon its approval.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the managers of your Committee on Conference that is attached to this report, your Committee on Conference is in accord with the intent and purpose of S.B. No. 806, H.D. 1, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Final Reading in the form attached hereto as S.B. No. 806, H.D. 1, C.D. 1.


