Your Committees on Education and Water & Land, to which was referred S.B. No. 806 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO PUBLIC SCHOOL LANDS,"

beg leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to require the Attorney General, on behalf of the Department of Education, to institute proceedings to acquire certain land owned by the Mililani Town Association by voluntary action or condemnation.

Your Committees received testimony in support of this measure from the Department of Education. Your Committees received comments on this measure from the Department of the Attorney General.

Your Committees find that the Mililani Town Association owns certain parcels of land near Mililani High School. Your Committees further find that the Department of Education intends to use the land to build an access ramp that is compliant with the Americans for Disabilities Act for students, staff, family members, and the general public to use. Your Committees additionally find that the acquisition of the parcels of land will also give control of a certain walkway that cuts through Mililani High School to the Department of Education, which will reduce cases of vagrancy and ensure safety and security of the school.




This measure provides a legal process for the acquisition of the parcels of land by the State in a manner agreeable to all parties.


Your Committees have amended this measure by changing its effective date to July 1, 2050.


