Your Committee on Energy, Economic Development, and Tourism,
to which was referred S.B. No. 80 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE ECONOMY,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose and intent of this measure is to amend the law
relating to the economy.

Prior to the hearing on this measure, your Committee posted
and made available for public review a proposed S.D. 1, which
amends this measure by deleting its contents and replacing it with
language that requires the Bureau of Conveyance to amend its rules
to establish a new fee schedule for certain general, land court,
and regular system fees in order to:


- (1) Assist local residents in participating in the Hawaii
housing market by modifying fees charged by the Bureau
of Conveyances;
- (2) Stimulate growth of the local economy by promoting
homeownership for residents; and
- (3) Provide increased revenues for the Bureau of Conveyances
to maintain its operation.

Your Committee has amended this measure by adopting the
proposed S.D. 1.
