Your Committee on Water and Land, to which was referred S.C.R. No. 19 entitled:

"SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A TERM, NON-EXCLUSIVE EASEMENT COVERING A PORTION OF STATE SUBMERGED LANDS AT MAUNALUA, HONOLULU, OAHU, FOR THE EXISTING SEAWALL, AND FOR USE, REPAIR, AND MAINTENANCE OF THE EXISTING IMPROVEMENTS CONSTRUCTED THEREON,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose and intent of this measure is to authorize the issuance of a term, non-exclusive easement for the portion of state submerged lands fronting the property identified as Tax Map Key: (1) 3-9-016:036, Maunalua, Honolulu, Oahu, for the existing seawall, and for the use, repair, and maintenance of existing improvements constructed thereon, pursuant to section 171-53, Hawaii Revised Statutes.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure from the Department of Land and Natural Resources and Daisho Co., Ltd.

Your Committee finds that, pursuant to section 171-53, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the Board of Land and Natural Resources may lease submerged lands with the prior approval of the Governor and the prior authorization of the Legislature by concurrent resolution. Your Committee further finds that in its meeting on July 10, 2020, under agenda item D-5, the Board of Land and

Natural Resources, subject to conditions, approved a grant of a twenty-five-year non-exclusive easement to resolve the one hundred thirty-eight square foot seawall encroachment. Following testimony and discussion, your Committee notes that the fair market value of the easement is currently being appraised. Your Committee concludes that the easement is necessary for the use, repair, and maintenance of the existing seawall.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Water and Land that is attached to this report, your Committee concurs with the intent and purpose of S.C.R. No. 19 and recommends that it be referred to your Committee on Ways and Means.
