Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred S.C.R. No. 201, S.D. 1, H.D. 1, entitled:

"SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION URGING THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII AND UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII PROFESSIONAL ASSEMBLY TO CONVENE A TASK FORCE TO EXAMINE AND ASSESS THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII TENURE SYSTEM FOR RESEARCHERS AND OTHER NON-INSTRUCTIONAL FACULTY, AND COMPENSATION STRUCTURE OF FACULTY ENGAGED IN ACTIVITIES SUPPORTED BY EXTRAMURAL FUNDING AND GRANTS, IN COMPARISON TO PEER HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS ACROSS THE UNITED STATES; AND PROPOSE THE BEST PRACTICES TO BE IMPLEMENTED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to urge the University of Hawaii and the University of Hawaii Professional Assembly to convene a task force to examine and assess the University of Hawaii's:

- (1) Tenure system for researchers and other non-instructional faculty; and
- (2) Compensation structure of faculty engaged in activities supported by extramural funding for grants;


