Your Committee on Transportation, to which was referred S.C.R. No. 239 entitled:

"SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO INCREASE THE USE OF RECLAIMED ASPHALT PAVEMENT TO REPAVE, RECONSTRUCT, AND PRESERVE STATE STREETS, ROADS, AND HIGHWAYS AND EXPLORE USE OF OTHER PRODUCTS USING RECLAIMED ASPHALT,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to urge the Department of Transportation to increase the use of reclaimed asphalt pavement to repave, reconstruct, and preserve state streets, roads, and highways and explore use of other products using reclaimed asphalt.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure from the Department of Transportation, Oahu Motorsports Association, and one individual.

Your Committee finds that the use of reclaimed asphalt pavement to repave, reconstruct, and preserve state streets and roads is better for the environment and provides a more cost-effective method for the State as it uses recycled materials to repair or construct a roadway. Your Committee further finds that the Federal Highway Administration supports and promotes the use of recycled highway material in pavement construction due to

its benefits and cost-saving opportunities. This measure will encourage the use of reclaimed asphalt pavement in future repair and construction projects for the State's streets and roads.
