RELATING TO STATE GOVERNMENT.

EET/HRE, WAM

Abolishes the office of aerospace development, aerospace advisory committee, and the Hawaii unmanned aerial systems test site advisory board. Transfers administration of the Pacific international space center for exploration systems from the department of business, economic development, and tourism to the University of Hawaii at Hilo Imiloa. Transfers the administration, along with all rights, powers, functions, and duties of the Challenger center Hawaii program from the office of aerospace development to the department of education. Transfers all appropriations for the Challenger center Hawaii program from the office of aerospace development to the department of education. Effective 7/1/2050. (Proposed SD1)
