SB 1328 Status & Testimony	RELATING TO ACADEMIC TENURE AT THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII. Limits the award of academic tenure to positions whose primary duties are instructional.	HRE, JDC
SB 1394 Status & Testimony	RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII. Requires that twenty-five per cent of a University of Hawaii research faculty's salary be paid out of the extramural funds and research and training revolving fund generated by the unit at which the faculty works or holds tenure. Requires grants, contracts, and agreements applied for or entered into beginning on July 1, 2021, that provide for extramural funds for use by a research faculty to include express provision allowing such funds to be used to pay for the research faculty's salary. Defines research faculty.	HRE, WAM
SB 1393 Status & Testimony	RELATING TO THE RESEARCH CORPORATION OF THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII. Places an unspecified cap on the management fees the research corporation of the University of Hawaii charges the University of Hawaii to support research and training.	HRE, WAM
