#### LEGISLATURE PASSES BILLS CO-SPONSORED BY REP. HAR

**Affirmative Consent (HB 451 / SB387)** – Establishes an affirmative consent task force to review and make recommendations on the University of Hawai'i's executive policy on domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, and stalking.

Kupuna Care Program (HB 497 / SB964) - Appropriates funds for the Kupuna Care Program.

Historic Preservation Review Exemption for Single Family Homes (HB 830) — Creates an exemption from DLNR historic review for proposed projects on privately-owned single-family detached dwelling units or townhouses that meet certain criteria.

**Veterans Exemption – State Vehicle Registration Fee (HB 1153)** – Exempts qualifying totally and permanently disabled veterans from paying the state motor vehicle registration fee. Requires the Director of the Office of Veterans Services to report the number of qualifying veterans to the Legislature and Department of Taxation.

**Supporting Our Troops (HCR 3)** – The Legislature passed a resolution strongly opposing the United States Army's proposed force reduction at Schofield Barracks and Fort Shafter. The proposed force reduction would result in the loss of 20,000 civilian jobs, and a nearly \$1.35 billion adverse impact on Hawai'i's economy.
