**Title of Bill:** SB 0144, SD1 RELATING TO A SCHOOL SUPPLY SUBSIDY PILOT PROGRAM.

**Purpose of Bill:** Establishes and makes an appropriation for a one-year school supply subsidy pilot program at Na'alehu elementary school. (SD1)

**Department's Position:**

The Hawaii State Department of Education (Department) supports the intent of SB 144 provided that its passage does not replace or adversely impact priorities as indicated in the Department's Board of Education-approved budget. The Department acknowledges the negative impact that financial and geographic challenges have on student achievement and overall student success.
