A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO IMPEACHMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The Hawaii Revised Statutes is amended by
2 adding a new chapter to title 3 to be appropriately designated
3 and to read as follows:

"CHAPTER

IMPEACHMENT OF THE GOVERNOR; LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR

6 § -1 **Articles of impeachment; hearing.** Impeachment of
7 the governor or lieutenant governor shall be instituted in the
8 house of representatives by introduction and adoption of a
9 resolution appointing managers of the house of representatives
10 to prepare and recommend articles of impeachment on the house
11 floor, and if adopted, deliver the articles of impeachment to
12 the senate for the senate's consideration to prosecute. The
13 hearing shall be heard before the senate sitting as a court of
14 impeachment. Each house shall adopt rules to carry out the
15 provisions of this chapter.

16 § -2 Causes for impeachment. The house of
17 representatives shall have the power of impeachment of the

1 governor or lieutenant governor for malfeasance in office,
2 corruption, dereliction of duty, or other high crimes or
3 misdemeanors. Impeachment shall not extend beyond removal from
4 office and disqualification to hold and enjoy any office of
5 honor, trust, or profit under the State, but the person
6 convicted may be liable and subject to indictment, trial,
7 judgment, and punishment as provided by law."

8 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.


