A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO INFORMATION PRIVACY AND SECURITY COUNCIL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. The legislature finds it to be in the best 1
- 2 interest of the public to allow each member of the information
- 3 privacy and security council to appoint a designee to act on the
- member's behalf to ensure quorum. 4
- SECTION 2. Section 487N-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 5
- amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 6
- 7 There is established an information privacy and "(a)
- security council within the department of accounting and general 8
- services for administrative purposes only. Members of the 9
- council shall be appointed no later than September 1, 2008, by 10
- the governor without regard to section 26-34 and shall be 11
- composed of the following representatives: 12
- (1) Executive agencies that maintain extensive 13
- personal information in the conduct of their duties, 14
- including the department of commerce and consumer 15
- affairs, the department of education, the department of 16
- 17 health, the department of human resources development,

1		the department of human services, and the University of
2		Hawaii, to be selected by the governor;
3	(2)	The legislature, to be selected by the president
4		of the senate and the speaker of the house of
5		representatives;
6	(3)	The judiciary, to be selected by the chief
7		justice of the Hawaii supreme court; and
8	(4)	The four counties, to be selected by the mayor of
9		each county; provided that the mayor of each county
10		shall determine the extent to which the county may or
11		may not participate.
12	Each	member of the council may designate a person from that
13	member's agency to attend meetings and act on the member's	
14	behalf, including for voting purposes, when the member is unable	
15	to attend a meeting. The chief information officer or the chief	
16	information officer's designee shall serve as chair of the	
17	council."	
18	SECT	ION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
19	SECT	ION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
