# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREWORKS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the use of illegal
- 2 fireworks has substantially increased in recent years.
- 3 The purpose of this Act is to require the fireworks and
- 4 articles pyrotechnic records auditor for each county to submit
- 5 an annual report to the legislature detailing inventory,
- 6 recordkeeping, and sales of fireworks to license or permit
- 7 holders.
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 132D-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 9 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- 10 "(a) The fee for the license required under section 132D-7
- 11 shall be \$3,000 for importers, \$2,000 for each wholesaler's
- 12 site, \$1,000 for each storage site, and \$500 for each retailer's
- 13 site for each year or fraction of a year in which the licensee
- 14 plans to conduct business and shall be payable to the county.
- 15 The license fees shall be used solely by each county fire
- 16 department to pay for the salary of an auditor of fireworks and
- 17 articles pyrotechnic records and all expenses incurred to
- 18 fulfill the duties required, including the inspection of 2022-3177 SB2185 CD1 SMA.doc



- 1 inventory and storage facilities, maintenance of required
- 2 records, and the training of the auditor. The auditor of
- 3 fireworks and articles pyrotechnic records shall monitor strict
- 4 inventory and recordkeeping requirements to ensure that sales of
- 5 fireworks or articles pyrotechnic are made only to license or
- 6 permit holders under this chapter. The auditor of fireworks and
- 7 articles pyrotechnic records shall submit an annual report to
- 8 the legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening
- 9 of each regular session detailing the inventory, recordkeeping,
- 10 and sales of fireworks to license or permit holders. The county
- 11 shall provide an exemption from the fees under this section to
- 12 nonprofit community groups for importation and storage of
- 13 fireworks or articles pyrotechnic for displays once a year."
- 14 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 15 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2023.
