A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FILING FEES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that having different 2 filing fee schedules for divorce and paternity actions creates a 3 burdensome and confusing situation for low-income litigants. 4 Although the waiver of initial filing fees for termination of 5 parental right actions, including paternity actions, was 6 intended to reduce the burden on unmarried litigants who may 7 have less ability to pay the initial filing fee, the fees to 8 file subsequent motions still create significant ongoing expense 9 in paternity cases. Eliminating fees to file motions and 10 increasing the initial filing fee in paternity cases to match 11 the filing fee in divorce cases will reduce uncertainty 12 regarding the cost of paternity actions by requiring a single 13 fee at the initiation of the case, as opposed to an unknown 14 number of fees as the case progresses.

Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to alter the filing fee schedules for actions to determine father and child relationships to achieve parity with divorce cases by:
