## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FISHING.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 188, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	"§188- Possession or use of unmanned aerial vehicles on,
5	in, or near state marine waters prohibited; exception. (a) It
6	is unlawful to possess or use on, in, or near state marine
7	waters, any unmanned aerial vehicles, for the purpose of taking
8	aquatic life, except under the terms and conditions of a permit
9	first obtained by the user from the department of land and
10	natural resources; provided that unmanned aerial vehicles may be
11	used for the purpose of simple reconnaissance. The department
12	of land and natural resources may issue permits for the
13	possession or use of unmanned aerial vehicles consistent with
14	other legal requirements.
15	(b) As used in this section, "unmanned aerial vehicle"
16	means any aerial vehicle that is operated without the
17	possibility of direct human intervention within or on the aerial
18	vehicle."

- 4 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
