A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT COST ITEMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 PART I

2 SECTION 1. There are appropriated or authorized from the
3 sources of funding indicated below to collective bargaining
4 statewide (BUF 102) the following sums or so much thereof as may
5 be necessary to fund for fiscal biennium 2021-2023 all
6 collective bargaining cost items in the agreement negotiated
7 with the exclusive representative of collective bargaining
8 unit (3):

11 indicated below to Hawaii health systems corporation - corporate
12 office (HTH 210) the following sums or so much thereof as may be
13 necessary to fund for fiscal biennium 2021-2023 the salary
14 increases and other adjustments authorized by chapter 89C,
15 Hawaii Revised Statutes, for state officers and employees who
16 are excluded from collective bargaining, assigned to the Hawaii
17 health systems corporation, and belong to the same compensation
18 plans as those officers and employees within bargaining
19 unit (3):

1 SECTION 12. Funds authorized by this part shall be
2 allotted by the director of finance to the Hawaii health systems
3 corporation for expenditure in the respective fiscal year for
4 the purposes of this part.

5 PART VII

6 SECTION 13. Salary increases and cost adjustments provided
7 in this Act for any officer or employee whose compensation is
8 paid, in whole or in part, from federal, special, or other funds
9 shall be paid wholly or proportionately, as the case may be,
10 from the respective funds.

11 SECTION 14. The fiscal year 2021-2022 appropriations or
12 authorizations under this Act shall not lapse until the end of
13 fiscal biennium 2021-2023; provided that funds appropriated or
14 authorized by this Act that are not expended or encumbered by
15 June 30, 2023, shall lapse as of that date.

16 SECTION 15. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
