1	SECTION 5. Salary increases and cost adjustments provided
2	in this Act for any officer or employee whose compensation is
3	paid, in whole or in part, from federal, special, or other funds
4	shall be paid wholly or proportionately, as the case may be,
5	from the respective funds.
6	SECTION 6. The fiscal year 2021-2022 appropriations or
7	authorizations under this Act shall not lapse until the end of
8	fiscal biennium 2021-2023; provided that funds appropriated or
9	authorized by this Act that are not expended or encumbered by
10	June 30, 2023, shall lapse as of that date.
