
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1 SECTION 13. Salary increases and cost adjustments provided 2 in this Act for any officer or employee whose compensation is 3 paid, in whole or in part, from federal, special, or other funds 4 shall be paid wholly or proportionately, as the case may be, 5 from the respective funds. SECTION 14. The fiscal year 2021-2022 appropriations or 6 authorizations under this Act shall not lapse until the end of 7 fiscal biennium 2021-2023; provided that funds appropriated or 8

9 authorized by this Act that are not expended or encumbered by10 June 30, 2023, shall lapse as of that date.

11 SECTION 15. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
