Dear Senate President Kouchi and Speaker Saiki:

The Hawai'i Government Employees Association (HGEA) and the employer have reached an agreement concerning collective bargaining (CB) for Unit 6 (Educational Officers). Notification of ratification of the CB agreement was issued on April 12, 2022. In accordance with Section 89-10(b), cost items must be submitted to the Legislature for appropriation. The following summary of the included and excluded requirements of the settlement for the current fiscal biennium is being transmitted to the Legislature for authorization:
