# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STATE BUDGET.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	PART I. GENERAL PROVISIONS
2	SECTION 1. This Act shall be known and may be cited as the
3	Judiciary Supplemental Appropriations Act of 2022.
4	SECTION 2. Act 127, Session Laws of Hawaii 2021, is
5	amended by amending part II to read as follows:
6	"PART II. PROGRAM APPROPRIATIONS
7	SECTION 3. The following sums, or so much thereof as may
8	be sufficient to accomplish the purposes and programs designated
9	herein, are appropriated or authorized from the sources of
10	funding specified to the judiciary for the fiscal biennium
11	beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2023. The total
12	expenditures and the number of permanent and temporary positions
13	established in each fiscal year of the fiscal biennium shall not
14	exceed the sums and the position ceilings indicated for each
15	year, except as provided in this Act.

- 6 improvement projects shall be expended by the judiciary for the
- 7 projects listed below; provided that several related or similar
- 8 projects may be combined into a single project, if a combination
- 9 is advantageous or convenient for implementation; provided
- 10 further that the total cost of the projects thus combined shall
- 11 not exceed the total of the sums specified for the projects
- 12 separately. The amount after each cost element and the total
- 13 funding for each project listed in this part are in thousands of
- 14 dollars.

SECTION 4. Act 127, Session Laws of Hawaii 2021, is 1 2 amended by amending part V to read as follows: 3 "PART V. ISSUANCE OF BONDS 4 SECTION 8. General obligation bonds may be issued, as 5 provided by law, to yield the amount that may be necessary to finance projects authorized in part II and listed in part [\forall ] IV 6 of this Act; provided that the sum of the general obligation 7 8 bonds so issued shall not exceed [\$8,086,000.] \$20,220,000." 9 SECTION 5. There is appropriated out of the general 10 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$300,000 or so much 11 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 to support the judiciary's Ōlelo Hawai'i projects as follows: 12 13 (1) \$100,000 for a program coordinator; and \$200,000 for implementation, including translation 14 (2) 15 services, website upgrades, preparation of materials, 16 and educational efforts. 17 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary for 18 the purposes of this Act. SECTION 6. If any portion of this Act or its application 19

to any person or circumstances is held to be invalid for any

reason, the remainder of the Act and any provision thereof shall

- 1 not be affected. If any portion of a specific appropriation is
- 2 held to be invalid for any reason, the remaining portion shall
- 3 be independent of the invalid portion and shall be expended to
- 4 fulfill the objective and intent of the appropriation to the
- 5 extent possible.
- 6 SECTION 7. If any manifest clerical, typographical, or
- 7 other mechanical error is found in this Act, the chief justice
- 8 may correct the error. All changes made pursuant to this
- 9 section shall be reported to the legislature at its next regular
- 10 session.
- 11 SECTION 8. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 12 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- SECTION 9. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2022.
