A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE REDUCED IGNITION PROPENSITY CIGARETTE PROGRAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. The purpose of this Act is to:
2	(1)	Authorize the use of the reduced ignition propensity
3		cigarette program special fund to support the duties
4		and responsibilities of the state fire council in
5		addition to administering and enforcing the reduced
6		ignition propensity cigarette program; and
7	(2)	Appropriate \$70,000 from the reduced ignition
8		propensity cigarette program special fund for fiscal
9		year 2022-2023 for these purposes.
10	SECT	ION 2. Section 132C-9, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
11	amended b	y amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
12	"(b)	Moneys in the reduced ignition propensity cigarette
13	program s	pecial fund shall be administered and expended by the
14	state fir	e council [to] as follows:

(1) To defray the actual cost of activities and

requirements of section 132C-4, including employing

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1	one full-time administrator and one full-time
2	assistant whose duties shall include:
3	$[\frac{(1)}{(1)}]$ Adopting administrative rules for program
4	implementation, establishing compliance
5	inspections, and approving forms and enforcement
6	procedures and guidelines;
7	$[\frac{(2)}{(B)}]$ Receiving certifications for approximately $[\frac{\sin x}{\sin x}]$
8	eight hundred different brands and styles of
9	cigarettes from the manufacturers;
10	$[\frac{(3)}{(C)}]$ Compiling a list of the cigarette brands and
11	styles for which manufacturers have submitted
12	certifications, verifying tax stamp compliance
13	with the department of the attorney general, and
14	posting the list of certified brands and styles
15	on a state website for informational purposes
16	only;
17	$[\frac{(4)}{(D)}]$ Reviewing and approving, as needed, any
18	alternative test methods or fire standard
19	compliance markings submitted by the
20	manufacturer; and

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1	$[\frac{(5)}{(E)}]$ If needed, submitting certified cigarettes to an		
2	accredited laboratory for testing to verify that		
3	performance standards have been $met[+]$; and		
4	(2) To defray the cost of statewide fire prevention,		
5	education, life safety, and preparedness programs,		
6	especially as they relate to youth, seniors, and		
7	persons with disabilities, including the hiring of		
8	administrative personnel."		
9	SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the reduced		
10	ignition propensity cigarette program special fund the sum of		
11	\$70,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year		
12	2022-2023 for the purposes described in section 132C-9(b)(2),		
13	Hawaii Revised Statutes, as amended by section 2 of this Act.		
14	The sum appropriated shall be expended by the state fire		
15	council for the purposes of this Act.		
16	SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed		
17	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.		
18	SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2060.
