
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PEER-TO-PEER CAR SHARING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 291C, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to part XII to be appropriately
3	designated and to read as follows:
4	"§291C- Peer-to-peer car-sharing; prohibited. (a) No
5	person shall operate, use, or control a peer-to-peer car-sharing
6	program in the State.
7	(b) For the purposes of this section, "peer-to-peer
8	car-sharing program" means a business platform that connects
9	vehicle owners with drivers to enable the sharing of vehicles
10	for financial consideration. "Peer-to-peer car-sharing program"
11	does not mean lessor as defined in section 437D-3.
12	"Peer-to-peer car-sharing program" is not a car-sharing
13	organization as defined in section 251-1."
14	SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
15	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
