
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
THIRTY-FIRST REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$26,261,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2022-2023
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the thirty-
6 first representative district, as follows:

7 1. Admiral Arthur W. Radford high school
8 Plans, design, construction, and
9 equipment for renovation of the
10 gymnasium bathrooms and boys' and
11 girls' locker rooms to include shower,
12 basins, and toilets.


4 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project

9 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as
10 of June 30, 2024, shall lapse as of that date.

11 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2022.
