A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOBILE ELECTRONIC DEVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 291C-137, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (f) to read as follows:
- 3 "(f) Every person who violates this section shall be
- 4 subject to a fine of [\$250] \$300 that shall be deposited into
- 5 the state highway fund; provided that if a person violates this
- 6 section while operating a motor vehicle in a school zone or
- 7 construction area, as defined in section 291C-104, the fine
- 8 shall be [\$300,] \$400, which shall be [paid to the director of
- 9 finance pursuant to section 291C-171.] deposited into the safe
- 10 routes to school program special fund established under section
- 11 291C-4."
- 12 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 13 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 14 begun before its effective date.
- 15 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 16 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 17 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2022.
