

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PLANNED COMMUNITY ASSOCIATIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 421J, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	"§421J- Installation of security cameras. No
5	association may:
6	(1) Assess a fine to any member or tenant of a unit; or
7	(2) Require a member or tenant of a unit to undergo an
8	architectural review by the association's
9	architectural review committee,
10	for any security camera that is commercially available to the
11	general public for home security use on the exterior of a
12	member's or tenant's unit if installed three or more years prior
13	to the effective date of this Act or if installed by or on
14	behalf of a previous member or tenant who occupied the unit;
15	provided that the association may assess a fine on the member or
16	tenant of a unit if the security camera is installed in a
17	haphazard fashion such that external wiring is visible."

Report Title:

Planned Community Associations; Security Cameras; Installation

Description:

Prohibits any planned community association from assessing a fine or requiring an architectural review for any security camera commercially available to the general public on the exterior of a member's or tenant's unit if installed for a certain duration or if installed by or on behalf of a previous member or tenant who occupied the unit. Authorizes a fine if the security camera is installed in a haphazard fashion.

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
