A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE OFFICE OF THE LONG-TERM CARE OMBUDSMAN PROGRAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general
- 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 to
- 4 fund five full-time equivalent (5.0 FTE) long-term care
- 5 ombudsman program specialist positions within the office of the
- 6 long-term care ombudsman; provided that the positions shall be
- 7 allocated and serve as follows:
- 8 (1) One position for the city and county of Honolulu;
- 9 (2) Two positions for the county of Hawaii;
- 10 (3) One position for the county of Kauai; and
- 11 (4) One position for the county of Maui.
- 12 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the executive
- 13 office on aging for the purposes of this Act.
- 14 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
