BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 571-87, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsections (b) and (c) to read as follows
3	"(b) The court shall determine the amount of reasonable
4	compensation paid to appointed counsel and guardian ad litem,
5	based on the following rates:
6	(1) [\$90] \$ an hour for in-court services
7	provided by an attorney licensed to practice law in
8	the State; [and]
9	(2) [\$60] <u>\$</u> an hour for[÷
10	(A) Out-of-court out-of-court services provided by
11	an attorney licensed to practice law in the

13	[(B)] <u>(3)</u> [All] \$ an hour for all services
14	provided by a person who is not an attorney
15	licensed to practice law in the State, whether
